

WORKERS' MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM

2010-2011

APPLICATIONS ARE DUE BY MARCH 1, 2010

Oregon residents who have graduated from high school or hold a GED are eligible to apply for a Workers' Memorial Scholarship if they are either:

1. spouses or dependents of an Oregon worker who incurred a permanent and total disability** (PTD) resulting from an on-the-job injury while working for an Oregon employer;
- or**
2. spouses or dependents of an Oregon worker who incurred a fatal on-the-job injury** while working for an Oregon employer.

****To be a qualifying permanent total disability or fatal injury there must be a record of an accepted workers' compensation insurance claim on file with the Workers' Compensation Division of the Department of Consumer and Business Services.**

The Workers' Memorial Scholarship Program is administered by Oregon OSHA, a division of the Department of Consumer and Business Services.

The final deadline for submitting a scholarship application for the 2010-2011 academic year is **March 1, 2010**.
